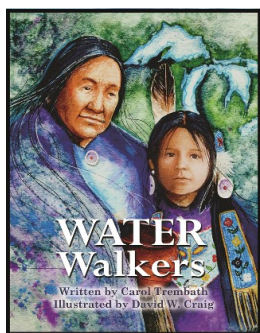

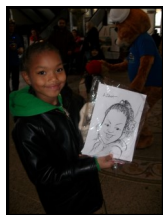


Water Walkers

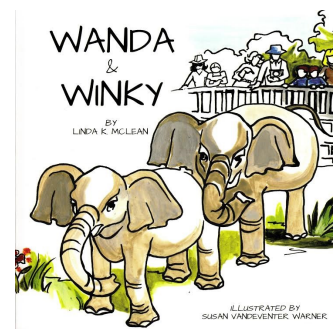
